International Student - Exchange Programmes

- Sapienza University promotes and favors students exchange programs
- ERASMUS for EU countries with most Universities in Spain, France, UK, Germany
- **Extra UE countries : South America, Russian Federation Universities**
- **Each University establishes selection of students and scholarships for their own students.**

Programs for students

- **Courses are taught in Italian. If students are allowed to attend courses and take exams they have to be proficient in Italian.**
- **Learning agreement has to be presented professor responsible for exchange who will contact the president of degree course.**
- **University credits acquired by students during mobility programs are recognized in own University**
- **Internships from at least 3 months to 1 year**
- **English language is required for short internships (of at least 3 months during term)**

Bilateral Agreement Scholarships - Non-EU Mobility

- Bilateral mobility agreements between Sapienza University and other universities provide reciprocal advantages both to outgoing and incoming students as **neither have to pay any additional tuition fees**. Outgoing students will continue to normally pay tuition fees at their university, NOT at the host university.

- **Bilateral mobility calls are managed by individual faculties and published on their websites.**

Deadlines

- In order to participate in the exchange programme, students must be selected by their university and presented as a candidate by the following deadlines:
- **April 15 - for the 1st semester (September to February)**
- **October 15 - for the 2nd semester (March to July)**
- In order to complete their registration, students will have to upload their passport, curriculum vitae, academic transcript and learning agreement, as well as their **Italian/English language certificate (B1/B2 level)**, according to the language of the courses they plan to attend.
- **A free Italian language course will be available for exchange students.**

Tutoring and Orientation

- The Student Tutoring and Orientation Service has a central office located in University City and branches located in the Faculties.
- There is a RAMs (Referent for Academic Mobility) for each Degree Course
